School Rules

We live and learn together at school.

Therefore, everyone should feel safe and comfortable: students, school staff, parents and visitors.

To make this possible, we have our school rules.

1. Your behaviour at school

1.1. In general, you are expected to behave in a social and respectful way:

1.1.1. Help others when they need help.

1.1.2. No arguments, no insults, no violence (also no play fighting).

1.1.3. If you have problems, talk to a teacher or a supervising person.

1.2. You must follow the instructions of teachers and school staff.

1.3. Speak German during school time.

1.4. No drugs, alcohol, energy drinks or smoking substances.

1.5. No dangerous objects.

1.6. Other rules (mobile phones, tablets, training room, toilets, latecomers' group) must be followed.

1.7. The school is not responsible for lost or damaged valuables.

1.8. The administrative area (= teachers' area) and the middle stairway are not passageways.



2. Order and cleanliness at school

- 2.1. No running or ball games inside the building.
- 2.2. No eating, drinking and chewing gum during lessons.
- 2.3. Do not damage school property or other people's belongings.
- 2.4. Rubbish must be put into the correct bin.
- 2.5. Come to school wearing suitable clothes.
- 2.6. No caps or hats during lessons.

3. Before lessons

- 3.1. From 7:45 a.m., you may enter the schoolyard.
- 3.2. Get off bicycles and e-scooters before the schoolyard.
- 3.3. At 7:55 a.m., go directly to your classroom.
- 3.4. At 8:00 a.m., the entrance door is closed.
 - 3.4.1. If you are late, go to the latecomers' group.

4. Break times

- 4.1. 5-minute transition break:
 - Stay in the classroom (except for toilet, water dispenser or room change).
- 4.2. Long breaks:
 - 4.2.1. Go directly to the schoolyard.
 - 4.2.2. Use the outdoor toilets.
 - 4.2.3. Do not throw objects.
 - 4.2.4. Be careful when playing.
 - 4.2.5. Go directly to your lesson after the bell.
- 4.3. The lunch break
 - 4.3.1. After the 4th lesson, leave the school building.
 - 4.3.2. Stay in the correct rooms for lunch or activities.
 - 4.3.3. Go directly to your lesson after the break.

If you break the school rules, you must expect consequences, up to exclusion from school.
